#### INN AT STARLIGHT LAKE UNDER NEW OWNERSHIP / MANAGEMENT

The Inn at Starlight Lake, formerly owned by Jack and Judy McMahon, has been sold to Jim and Sari Schwartz along with their partner, Joan Roy. The inn, which has been in operation since 1909, features a casual country atmosphere.

“We’re open year round,” says Jim Schwartz, “and there’s a lot to do in every season. We love kids too, so bring the whole family.”

In the winter, guests may enjoy cross-country skiing or visit the area’s downhill ski resorts. Spring and summer bring fly fishermen to the lake and area streams; biking and bird watching are also popular. The large, sparkling lake is a great place for boating and swimming. Autumn delivers colorful foliage for long walks, and there are areas nearby that allow hunting.

Starlight is now offering the “Inn to Inn Bike Tour”, a 4-day/3-night package that includes meals and a one-night stay at two other area inns.

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are available in the Inn’s restaurant, which is known for its freshly made pasta, bread, and desserts. The Inn also has many activities for children, including a family swim area on Starlight Lake. One child age 12 or under, per adult, stays free in the parents’ room using existing bedding (cots are available for an extra charge). While staying at the Inn and accompanied by family member dining from the adult menu, children age 12 or under may select a complimentary meal from the children’s menu. Limit 2 children per dining family.

Jim and Sari bring nearly 65 years of hospitality experience to the Inn. Joan Roy, former owner of a day spa in Connecticut, has a background that includes corporate finance, management and operation of food and beverage services and also has experience in wine selection. Plans are underway to upgrade the property and add more special programs and packages.

Sari, Jim and Joan are thrilled to be new members of the community and pledge to keep up and improve upon the traditions of the Inn at Starlight Lake.
